Registration Procedure For All Summer Camps & Activities

A waiver along with payment is due at registration. If registering AFTER May 12th, you must also put the child 's name in the program book on the table in the gym at The Bow Community Building. If a program is FULL, please put your child 's name and phone number on the waitlist. When filling out the waiver, please let us know of any concerns we should know about your child, health conditions or medications your child is on. Please let us know if your child carries an epi-pen or an inhaler. We will need to know your child' s doctor 's name & phone number and dates of last tetanus shots. Emergency numbers will be needed. Please inform us of any changes throughout the summer.
